WALL STICKERS INSTALLATION GUIDE

STEP BY STEP

- PREPARATION

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Clean cloth
- Scissors
- Masking tape
- Plastic squeegee (included)

WALL SURFACE

IMPORTANT!

WE KNOW YOU'RE EXCITED TO APPLY THE WALLPAPER, BUT IT'S IMPORTANT TO LET THE ADHESIVE REST (AT 17 °C +) FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS BEFORE APPLICATION.

- The surface must be perfectly smooth. Repair all holes and dents with plaster if needed. Let dry and sand.
- Apply a primer to the plaster, followed by gloss or semi-gloss paint to the surface needing covering.
- Do not install decals directly over plaster or primer. Leave to dry for 14 days or more before applying the wall paper.
- Before installation, wipe the surface with a damp cloth (without any cleaning products that might affect adhesion) and allow to dry.

- APPLICATION

HERE WE GO!

Step 1

- Unroll the sticker sheet, and using scissors, cut out each design leaving only a border of a few centimetres (for sticker sets only).
- Despite meticulous preparation in our workshops, it is recommended to use the plastic squeegee, exerting a sufficient pressure on the back of the graphic (waxed paper side) to ensure optimal adhesion of the transfer paper. Repeat with each one of the stickers.

Step 2

- Before removing the wax paper on the back, position the decals on the wall using masking tape. So you avoid positioning errors and ensure that the end result meets your expectations.
- Feel free to juxtapose or overlap the stickers. You may also cut them if you want to place them near a baseboard, window sill or crown molding.

Step 3

- While keeping the top part attached to the wall, fold a corner of the waxed paper behind.
- Slowly remove the waxed paper on the back by pulling down.
- Smooth the surface diagonally with the plastic squeegee to remove all air bubbles.
- If the wax paper does not come off completely, press the side of the transfer paper. It should pull out easily.

Step 4

• Once the sticker has been installed on the wall, carefully remove the transfer paper, without pulling upwards

HOW TO REMOVE

To remove a sticker, lift the top corner and slowly peel the vinyl down. If you can't peel it off, heat the vinyl with a hair dryer and continue to lift it diagonally. It will slowly detach with the heat.
